D eat:

- 2 It's quite expensive, but I always eat some seafood at least once a week.
- 3 We ate some mussels last night; they were delicious. They were the best mussels I have eaten for a long time.
- 4 I would like to eat caviar one day. It's not exactly "sea food", but it does come from a fish!
- 5 My brother **ate** caviar once at the wedding of his best friend.
- 6 My Mum says that we are going to (or will) eat some shellfish next weekend.
