Deaf as I am, I need a good hearing aid. 18 19 I don't hear very well; hence the hearing aid. 20 However difficult it is, there is no choice but to try. 21 While/Though it may be difficult, it is by no means impossible 22 Whatever/However great the difficulty, it must still be attempted. 23 I'll tell you when I see you. (I know I'm going to see you) 24 I'll tell you if I see you. (I don't know if I'll see you.) 25 I'll help you whenever I see you. (Every time I see you, I'll help you.) 26 I'll help you whether I see you or not. 27 We must finish the job, whatever/however long it takes. 28 We must finish the job, however/no matter how long it takes. 29 We must finish the job, **no matter** how long it takes. Hardly had the match begun than it started to rain. (note the inversion) 30 31 He did no preparation at all but passed the exam anyway. 32 I didn't fancy the fish so I had the meat instead. 33 Peter's father made him stay in. (ordered, compelled, forced) 34 The next day he let him go out. (allowed, permitted) 35 The dictator had the prisoners shot. (He ordered them to be shot.) 36 The number of accidents rises in proportion to the speed limit. 37 The number of accidents rises in line with the speed limit. 38 Driving on the left is no problem for me. I lived in the UK for 3 years, so I'm used to it. 39 He spent his time on entertainment instead of working. He spent his time on entertainment rather than working. 40
