

DO YOU KNOW YOUR TENSES? Use the verb shown to complete each sentence: (6+)

A drink:

- 1 I **drink** at least one glass of apple juice a day.
- 2 Yesterday, I **drank** three glasses.
- 3 This week so far I **have drunk** over 10 glasses of apple juice.
- 4 I **am drinking** one now as I write these words.
- 5 Mum says I **drink** too much juice, but I like **drinking** it.
- 6 Since I was a baby I **have always drunk** a lot of juice.

B ride

- 1 I **ride** my horse every day.
- 2 I usually **ride** him in the afternoons.
- 3 But I **didn't ride** him yesterday, because it was too hot.
- 4 I am **going to** (or **will**) **ride** him twice next Saturday instead. (anstatt)
- 5 My Mum likes **riding** ; but she **hasn't ridden** my horse yet.
- 6 I'm sure she **will** (or **is going to**) **ride** him one day soon!
- 7 Since I got my horse for my last birthday I **have ridden** him more than 30 times.
- 8 So far - touch wood - I **haven't fallen** off once. (use fall)

C drive:

- 1 My Dad is a farmer and he **drives** a tractor every day.
- 2 He has two tractors, an old one he **has driven** many times in the past and a new one.
- 3 The new one only arrived yesterday and **he hasn't driven** it yet.
- 4 I think he **is going to** (or **will**) **drive** it at the weekend.
- 5 Since I was about 8 I **have driven** my Dad's old tractor many times.
- 6 I **drive** it every summer when there is a lot of work to do.
- 7 I **drove** it a lot last year when I helped my Dad in the fields.
- 8 It is now March, and I **haven't driven** it yet this year.
- 9 I like **driving** tractors; it's fun.

D eat:

- 1 I love **eating** sea food.
- 2 It's quite expensive, but I always **eat** some seafood at least once a week.
- 3 We **ate** some mussels last night; they were delicious. They were the best mussels I **have eaten** for a long time.
- 4 I would like **to eat** caviar one day. It's not exactly "sea food", but it does come from a fish!
- 5 My brother **ate** caviar once at the wedding of his best friend.
- 6 My Mum says that we **are going to** (or **will**) **eat** some shellfish next weekend.

E wear:

- 1 My favourite shirt is red. I **am wearing** it now, but I never **wear** it to school.
- 2 I usually **wear** a clean shirt to school every day.
- 3 On Saturday, my Mum bought me a new shirt for school, but I **haven't worn** it yet. I think I **will wear** it next Monday.
- 4 Everyone at school can **wear** almost anything they like. One day last year my best friend **wore** pink trousers to school! He looked very funny.
